The responsible adult(s) should not allow young person(s)/vulnerable adult(s) in their care. To visit BUG CITY, TADPOLE BRIDGE, and PLAY AREAS. Without first assessing the level of risk and consider it safe for the persons in their charge to access or use these areas or the equipment. Climbing of ropes should not be allowed. <b>Before using the trampoline or other equipment the responsible adult should ask for an induction in the use of the equipment and independently assess the risks.</b>		✓

To visit the BEE HIVES without first assessing the level of risk and consider it safe for the persons in their charge to access the area. Particular care should be taken during hot weather when the bees are most active. Avoid the use of aftershave or perfume. Avoid sudden or erratic movements.		✓
